

AMCA Fan Efficiency Program Status

AMCA Standard on Fan Efficiency Classification (AMCA

DCS 205): A Subcommittee of the AMCA International Fan Committee has been working on this standard since late 2008. The most recent draft was sent to the Fan Committee and the Sub Committee for a final review. The committee is currently reviewing the comments now. The standard could be out to the membership by this October.

ASHRAE 90.1 - No change. ASHRAE TC5.1 task force provided minimum FEG efficiency levels to ASHRAE 90.1 Mechanical Subcommittee for 2010 edition.


White Paper: Completed. Board Approved.

ISO 12759: Enquiry Draft (ISO/DIS 27359) completed its five month review. The enquiry passed without any negative votes, so once the comments have been considered, the draft will move to the final stage of approval (a two month committee letter ballot). Almost 150 comments were received and the ISO/ TC117/WG 11 is planning on meeting in December to review/ resolve the comments.

Fan Efficiency Certification Program: The AMCA International Board Directed the formation of a task force to develop a statement of scope and work for the Fan Efficiency Assurance Program. The task force had its initial meeting and will be meeting again in early October. Issues that will need resolution are being identified.
