

USS Missouri Battleship Tour

1:00 pm \$115 per person

Built in the midst of World War II in the Brooklyn Navy Yard, USS Missouri (BB 63) is the youngest of her other lowa-class sisters; she was designed to be a fast battleship: a warship that balanced firepower and armor without sacrificing speed. Missouri's 887'3" (270.4m) length accommodated four large engines with 212,000 shaft horsepower, allowing the battleship to hit speeds over 33 knots, a significant improvement from the 27 knots of the previous class of battleship, the South Dakota class, and faster than the 26knot capability of Japanese ships of the time.

Today, guests will visit the USS Missouri escorted in a pre-approved vehicle with military access (specialized permit). The USS Missouri is located on Ford Island, a restricted active military installation. The vehicle is authorized to access Ford Island if it is free from bags, purses, or items that may provide

concealment. Everyone will be required to go through two security checkpoints where security will check the credentials of the tour operator and verify the vehicle is free of contraband.

At the USS Missouri, guests will partake in a 35-minute docent-led tour of the upper decks of the USS Missouri. Following the guided tour, guests are free to roam the ship on their own to explore both the upper and lower decks and the vendors located on the pier before returning to the resort.

Honolulu City Driving Tour

1:00 - 5:00 pm \$50 per person USD

Today's adventure is filled with many of Honolulu's most famous landmarks and buildings to include:

Punchbowl Cemetery - From the comfort of the tour vehicle, guests will view the dignified beauty of the National Memorial Cemetery of the Pacific at Punchbowl. The memorial cemetery was created to pay homage to those in the US Armed Forces whose lives were lost in the service of their country.

Na Pali Lookout - The Nu'uanu Pali Lookout offers panoramic views of the sheer Ko'olau cliffs and lush Windward Coast.

Iolani Palace - The residence of the Hawaii Kingdom royalty between 1845 and 1893. The only royal palace on US soil, the palace employs architectural design seen no place else. Its "American Florentine" design was created using brick with concrete facing, with ornamental plaster interior.

King Kamehameha Statue - Seen in pictures around the world as an archetype of Hawaii's regal past, the statue honors the monarch who founded the Kingdom of Hawaii, and one of the "must see" sites included in the tour.

Kawaiahao Church and Mission Houses-


Sometimes referred to as "Hawaii's Westminster Abbey", Kawaiahao Church was the chapel of the royal family. It's the oldest church on Oahu, and the Hawaiian language is still used during portions of services.

Hawaii State Capitol - The capitol houses the governor's office and state legislature. The American adaptation of the Bauhaus style of architecture provides a dramatic contrast to the well-preserved historic buildings located just blocks away.

Honolulu Hale - Literally, "Honolulu building" in the Hawaiian language, the building houses the mayor's chambers and is the seat of the government of the City and County of Honolulu.
