What to Pack

The weather in Santa Fe in late March reaches a high of 64° F and low of 32° F. Bring a jacket or sweater for the evening times. Be sure to bring comfortable shoes.

REMEMBER: Santa Fe is considered to be at a high altitude (almost 7000 feet above sea level), so the air is thinner and cooler, and the sun is stronger (bring a hat or sunscreen). The altitude can take a day or so to adjust to and staying hydrated helps. Watch your alcohol intake. One alcoholic drink is the equivalent of three at sea level.

A refund of the full conference fee, minus a \$100 administrative fee, will be given for cancellations received by that date. No refunds will be granted for requests submitted after March 21, 2025. All requests for exceptions to the cancellation/refund policy must be submitted in writing by the registrant with appropriate documentation no later than March 21, 2025. After that time, no refund considerations will be made.
